

MATTHEW N. HYNDMAN For insertion in the Otago Southland

Matthew Hyndman was born in Invercargill in 1881 . He received his early business
training with Messrs. Sargood Son & Ewen and later in 1906 commenced business
as a Bookseller. The company was based in Invercargill until 1937, when ill health
forced Matthew Hyndman to retire , and the company moved to Dunedin.

Mr. Hyndman was deeply involved with community affairs, being President of the
Invercargill Rugby Referees ' Association , a member of the board of the Invercargill
Savings Bank . and a member of the Invercargill Fire Board. Mr. Hyndman was also
a foundation member , a past president, and an honorary life member of the Rotary
Club , and for many years a member of the Bluff Harbour Board.

Mr. Hyndman died in 1946. age 65
